Preservice - Thirty minutes of music that is played before the ceremony, while guests are being seated.

Enchanted Occasions Music usually selects preservice music that is beautiful, tasteful, and appropriate. You are welcome to request one or more songs to be played during this time!

Processional Music - Songs that are played while the wedding party walks down the aisle at the beginning of the ceremony. Processional music is generally a slow, walking tempo.

Musical Interlude Pieces - Songs that are played during the ceremony for a candle lighting, rose ceremony, or other symbolic function.

Recessional Music - The song that is played immediately after the ceremony is over, while the wedding party exits the venue. Recessional songs are generally fast or upbeat in tempo, and reflect a celebratory mood.

Traditional Recessional Songs:

Postlude Song - This selection is played after the recessional song, while guests are leaving. This song can be fast or slow, upbeat or reflective.
