Formally trained since the age of two, Ms. Ramos attended such prestigious music programs as the Interlochen Arts Academy and Aspen Music Festival, before completing her bachelor's degree in violin performance at the Cleveland Institute of Music.

In recent years, Elizabeth has performed extensively with The Kingsbury Ensemble, The Bach Society, the Pittsburgh Ballet, and the Sphinx Chamber Orchestra at Carnegie Hall. Solo appearances with orchestra include a performance of Tchaikovsky's Violin Concerto with the Belleville, IL Philharmonic. Ms. Ramos has performed with famed pop group "The Black Eyed Peas" at the Edward Jones Dome, and with Stevie Wonder at the Scott Trade Center. Elizabeth completed a Masters Degree from the Hartt School of Music in 2018, and is currently working towards a doctorate in Violin Performance at Florida State University in Tallahassee, FL.
